SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The Lakes 8 Conference selected the following coaches as Coach of the Year for their sport: Greg Kobylak (Boys Soccer); Jack Nummerdor (Wrestling); Bob Dorman (Softball); Chad Brandow (Track). Jack Nummerdor was chosen overall Winter COY. Chad Brandow was chosen overall Spring COY.

Zach Gilson was Fruitport's first "First Team" All State soccer player. The Trojan **boys' soccer** team stopped the Spring Lake streak of 5 straight league championships with two overtime victories and an undefeated conference record.

The **Boys Track** team won the first **GMAA track championship** in school history, and was undefeated in conference competition.

The team of **Zach Gilson, Ben Kramer, Andrew Frost**, and **Shawn Knox** set a new record in the 4 x 200 relay of 1:30.82. **Zach Gilson** set the new school record I the long jump in the state meet with a leap of 22'-2".

The Trojan Baseball team won their first District championship since 1998. Coach **Nick Reed** was named District Coach of the Year. Pitcher **Austin Curtis** won all three games en route to the championship. **Mitch Reyes** was named first team All-State, the fourth baseball player in school history to earn this honor. Catcher **Kolin Lakatos** broke the previous school record with 40 RBI.

Francesca Cerneglia (Girls basketball) now holds the season rebounding record of 198.

A record 11 athletes were named to All-State teams this year. Chris Hendricks (football and wrestling) and Zack Gilson (soccer and track) earned those honors in two sports.

Fruitport Hosted MHSAA districts in boys soccer and Regional Semifinals in Girls Soccer. We also hosted the Lakes 8 Track Championships, and Invitational tournaments in Boys and Girls Tennis, Girls Golf, Volleyball, Bowling, Wrestling, Competitive Cheer, and Softball.

The Fruitport Athletic Foundation issued over \$15,000 in coach and athletic department grants for 14-15.

Sixteen athletes received the Athletic Foundation's **Outstanding Achievement Award** for receiving 6 or more Varsity letters in a four year career.
