• Mask-wearing update: While there was a ruling that nullifies our Governor's recent orders, there has been NO change in our current protocols. We started our district-level "benchmark" testing of all students through a new program called iReady. THe 4th and 5th graders are finished, the 2nd and 3rd graders will complete their testing this week. We use assessments that are nationally normed and in grades K – 5th the test is computer "adaptive". This means that if a child answers a question correctly, the test generates a question that is a bit more difficult and if the child answers incorrectly, the test generates a question that is a bit more simplistic. With this being a new program and the year of CoVid, we will be putting together an information sheet of how your child did on their assessment, and what you can expect as the year progresses.
