Section 31aa: Mental Health Supports

- Improve student mental health
- Estimated \$287,032 based on House Fiscal Projection
- Community Input
- Potential Expenses:
 - Arbor Circle
 - Contracted Psych offset
 - Year 2 student Psych intern
 - Additional supplies or materials for our emotional support team

Section 97c: Building Risk Assessments

- \$2,000 per building to create a building risk assessment
- FCS already has completed this process and has received the report

Section 97: School Safety Grant

- Improve student safety
- Estimated \$287,032 based on House Fiscal Projection
- The Building Risk Assessment will help the district allocate these funds

Section 97d: Critical Incidence Mapping

- The quote is on the board agenda
 - Should be fully funded
- Vendor will map our buildings

Section 97b: School Resource Officers

- Application just was released and it is competitive.
- Working with the township to see if there is any opportunities
- Cannot be used on our current SRO

Section 98c: Learning Loss

- All schools are eligible
- Estimated funding is \$50 per FTE (est. 2,650)
 - Could be more if districts do not accept the application
- Requirements:
 - Learning Loss Budget
 - Learning Loss Plan
 - Board Presentation
 - Metrics used to determine if plan is working

Section 98c: Learning Loss Cont.

- Metrics:
 - I-ready data from the current year along with historical trends from the previous years
 - PSAT and SAT for 9-11 grades
 - Early Warning Indicators for HS: Office Referrals, attendance and Grades for MTSS

Section 98c: Learning Loss Cont.

- What is Learning Loss:
 - ESSER II funds are to address learning loss among students
 - Administering high-quality, reliable assessments that can assess student academic progress and assist educators in meeting student needs, including by differentiating instruction.
 - Implementing evidence-based activities to meet the comprehensive needs of students.
 - Providing information and assistance to parents and families on ways to support students.
 - Tracking student performance and engagement in distance learning.

- Draft Budget/Plan (est \$132,500):
 - MTSS for the 2022-23 school year
 - Arbor Circle Parent Educator
 - Purchasing evidenced-based Tier 2 and Tier 3 interventions for math and reading for K-12
 - Interventionists
