- Ability to assume responsibility for supervising students, and to maintain cooperative working relationships with students, staff, parents and the general public with the understanding that confidentiality should be exhibited.

- Maintains a safe and orderly environment where student behavior is monitored and corrected, when needed.
- Learns the basics of robotics from experienced mentors, and establishes an excitement for student growth and competition.
- Manages the team's financial resources, in addition to the ordering of parts and materials for the season..

- Communicates with parents and students about team meetings and competition details.
