

Kindergarten Screening

As part of the kindergarten enrollment process, Fruitport Community Schools administers a brief screener to the incoming kindergarten students. The screener will cover topics such as cutting, letter-sound relationship, vocabulary, number recognition, as well as other pre-kindergarten skills. The screener will take approximately 30 minutes. The assessment is NOT going to determine if your child can attend kindergarten. The results of the screener will be used to create balanced classrooms as well as determine if your child may benefit from our transitional kindergarten classroom (TK).
