❖ Did you know... 

\*The minimum requirement for the Muskegon Promise is a 2.5 GPA as of this school year? \*Students receiving the Promise also receive a \$1000 stipend per year (\$500 per semester) to cover books, equipment, etc required by their classes?

\*Students now have up to 10 YEARS to use their Promise

\*Students opting to go to another college can still use their Promise as a guest student for summer classes to get ahead, retake a course they failed, etc.?

The Promise can be applied to trade classes, cosmetology and more?

Reach out to your counselor with questions.

All students in Personal Finance had the opportunity with support to complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). Parents or guardians still need to complete their part in order for it to be submitted. Check with your student. Most if not all colleges and scholarships will require that the FAFSA has been completed.
