TECHNOLOGY

Fruitport Community Schools is dedicated to integrating technology into the curriculum. Currently, every student in third through twelfth grade has 1:1 access to a Chromebook. Grades three through eight have a dedicated Chromebook cart in their classroom and grades nine through twelve have a Chromebook they are allowed to take home with them. Along with traditional Internet filtering, we use a very robust program called Go Guardian to be sure websites are filtered properly, even when the student is using the device in their home. Each classroom is equipped with a multi-media cart including a document camera, a networked PC, a DVD player, a microphone, a touch panel control system, and HD projector. We also have a cart of 10 Chromebooks in each building's media center, along with at least one floating cart per building. Kindergarten through second grade classrooms have either seven Chromebooks or seven tablets. **Elementary** There are five networked PCs in the media center, and one lab in each elementary building. In addition, Edgewood Elementary has a dedicated STEM lab. **Middle School** Every core academic classroom has a 32-station Chromebook cart, special education rooms have a 10-station cart, and additionally, there are two available computer labs for student use. Students participate in a standards-based curriculum that serves as an introduction to computers and information technology and there is also a LEGO Robotics course available for interested students.

High School The high school is a 1:1 Chromebook building. In addition, there are 25 networked PCs in the media center and three labs available for student use. Class offerings include: business services and technology (BST), web-page design, drafting and architecture, and Virtual Enterprises International.
